Rule 4-47 Delay of Game Warning

There are 4 delay of game warnings that may be penalized after any other team warning for delay.

Rule 4-47 states, "A warning to a team for a delay is an administrative procedure by an official which is recorded in the scorebook by the scorer and reported to the coach:

- **Art 1. For Throw in plane violations**
- Art 2. For huddle by either team and contact with the free thrower
- Art 3. For interfering with the ball following a goal
- Art 4. For failure to have the court ready for play following any time-out.

Note:

Delay of game warnings are only penalized with a technical foul after a warning has been recorded at some point in the game!

Other Delays

Failure to have a substitute ready after a player has been directed to the bench by the official or disqualified from the game.

Failure to have team out on the floor following the conclusion of halftime.
